

## Cutting:

Background: (Cut or Assemble)
4 ea: 48 1/2" X $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
2 ea: $\quad 641 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Dark: (from 77" X 27" cut in Clue 1)
2 ea: $\quad 561 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ 1/2"
2 ea. 76 1/2" X 6 1/2" Assembly:

1. Following diagram above, stitch a Clue 4, Step 3 unit to the long sides of a Clue 4, Step 4unit. Make 2 (top and bottom at right.)
2. Again following diagram at right, stitch a Clue 4, Step 4 unit to two opposite sides of the Clue 1 square in a Square unit. Make 1.
3. Now stitch a Step 1 unit to both long sides of Step 2 unit to complete the large Solitaire block as shown. Block should measure 48 1/2" X 48 1/2".
4. Stitch pairs of Clue 2, Set 2 Flying Geese together along short side. Stitch two sets of three pairs together along short side as shown. Units should measure 48 1/2" X 8 1/2"
5. Add $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X 48 1/2" Background strips to top and bottom of each of the flying geese strips. Make 2.

## Solitaire: Clue 5

 Final Solution
6. Borders: Add step 5 units to top and bottom of block as shown above (Watch orientation of Geese blocks.)
7. Add Background $641 / 2 "$ X $41 / 2 "$ strips to sides of quilt top.
8. Complete top by adding $61 / 2 " X 561 / 2 "$ dark strips to top and bottom and $761 / 2 "$ X $61 / 2 "$ strips to sides.
9. Layer. Quilt as desired. Bind with dark $21 / 2 "$ strips set aside in Clue 1.

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
