




2015 Block Of The Week: Oregon



Cutting:


Dark Blue:	A	2 ea.	9 1/2" X 2 1/2"
	B	2 ea.	2 1/2" X 5 1/2"
	C	4 ea.	1 1/2" X 1 1/2"
	F	2 ea.	2 1/2" X 2 1/2"
Gold:	D	2 ea.	3 1/2" X 5 1/2"



Assembly:

1. Snowball one dark blue C to a gold D corner as shown at right, *To snowball, mark/press diagonal on dark blue C squares. Lay C in corner of gold D. Stitch along C diagonal. Press C over stitching to form triangle. Trim excess to 1/4".* Repeat for an adjacent D corner. Make 2.
2. Snowball a dark blue F to lower corner of one D unit. Add the other F to the opposite corner of the other D unit to make the units mirror images.
3. Complete the heart design by stitching the two units together along the long edge, watching orientation, as shown.
4. Add the dark blue B patches to the sides of the Heart unit. Complete the block by adding the dark blue A patches top and bottom. Block should measure 9 1/2" X 9 1/2".

1. Snowball the C Patches to D. Make 2.
