2015 Block Of The Week: Virginia AND West Virginia

Cutting:

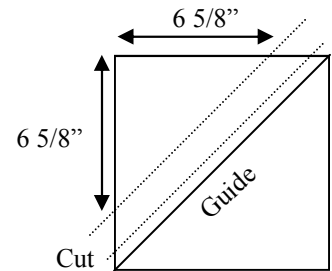
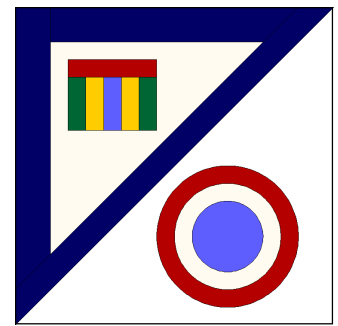
- White: 1 ea. 9 1/2" Square
- Dark Blue: 1 ea. 1 1/2" X 14"
- 1 ea. 1 1/2" X 8"
- 1 ea. 1 1/2" X 9"

Prep for Applique:

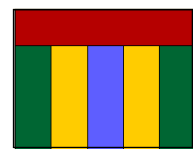
- Green: 2 ea. 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- Gold: 2 ea. 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- Lt. Blue: 1 ea. 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- 1 ea. 2" Circle
- White: 1 ea. 3" Circle
- Red: 1 ea. 4" Circle
- 1 ea. 1/2" X 2 1/2"

Assembly:

1. Press white 9 1/2" on one diagonal as a guide. Cut into two uneven pieces by trimming 1/4" beyond the guide. Take the smaller triangle and trim to 6 5/8".
2. Applique the little rectangles to the smaller triangle as shown at right placing 3/4" in and 3/4" down from the right angle corner.
3. Stitch the 8" dark blue strip to top of smaller triangle, matching the straight side. Next stitch the 9" strip on the adjacent side, again matching the straight side. Trim edges to match the diagonal edge. Add the 14" strip to the diagonal edge, centered. Trim edges.
4. Next position the circles placing the white on the red and the blue on the red, centered. Applique centered on the larger triangle.
5. Stitch the two triangles together to complete the block. Block should measure 9 1/2" square.



Cut 1/4" from pressed guide (diagonal). Trim remaining triangle to 6 5/8".
